


To offer the best remote support to assistive technology users and their caregivers











The MOvIT+™ program offers to assistive technology users and their caregivers a whole set of resources and services. MOvIT+™ facilitates a safe and satisfactory use of various types of assistive technologies (e.g. manual wheelchair, power wheelchair, wheeled base, four-wheel scooter and three-wheel scooter, rollator walker, walker and cane).

Once registered to MOvIT+™, you will be able to:

- Access to a website with useful information and resources, facilitating your use of assistive technologies;
- Get remote follow-up and coaching interventions following the reception of a new assistive technology;
- Identify the potential problems associated with the use of an assistive technology and learn the best ways to use it;
- Get advice from your rehabilitation center clinicians, according to your needs.

The MOvIT+™ program is currently in a pilot phase. Only assistive technology users and caregivers associated with the clinical teams of the CIUSSS du Centre-Sud-de-l'Île-de-Montréal, the CIUSSS du Centre-Ouest-de-l'Île-de-Montréal, the CIUSSS de la Capitale-Nationale, the Centre hospitalier universitaire de Sherbrooke and the CISSS de Laval can take part in the program.

How it works

How does the MOvIT+™ automated follow-up work?

Once you are registered to the program:

- Practical exercises and advice on how to adequately use the assistive technology will be sent to you;
- The MOvIT+™ automated system will ensure two follow-ups by e-mail, text message or phone: one month and three months after you receive your new assistive technology;
- You will be asked to complete follow-up questionnaires (using a computer, a tablet or a phone);
- Depending on the problems identified by questionnaires, MOvIT+™ will send you a list of resources tailored to your needs;
- A clinician may contact you to give you additional advice if needed.
